BERTON VINEYARD 2016 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The Berton Vineyard Range is selected from our vineyards set in High Eden, a region of rugged beauty between Eden Valley and the Barossa.

Vineyard and Vintage: Good winter rainfall was a perfect start to the 2016 growing season. Above average temperatures resulted in early budburst with most varieties. The mild to warm and dry conditions continued with good rainfall in both November and December producing ideal conditions for veraison. February saw the arrival of hot dry conditions and with no rainfall or disease pressure, ripening accelerated quickly meaning the reds were harvested early. The 2016 reds are stand outs - rich ripe juicy wines with great length and great depth of colour.

Tasting note: Set in High Eden, a region of rugged beauty between Eden Valley and the Barossa, our Cabernet Sauvignon is grown on ancient podsolic soils that offer lots of quartz rock and little other sustenance. Lovely lifted aromas of violets and sweet blackberry jam herald an intense and complex palate of ripe blackberry and cherry. Fine velvet tannins marry with vanillin coffee oak to create complexity and depth that persists to a long and flavorsome finish.
