Wombat Hill takes its name from one of Australia's most endearing native animals. The wombat is strong and sturdy and built close to the ground. Its propensity to move objects that get in its way has led to it being nicknamed the "Bulldozer of the Bush".

The Wombat Hill Chardonnay is a good honest appealing fruit driven wine that has aromas of candied lemon, lime and honeydew melon. The palate is a fusion of sweet citrus peardrop and ripe melon flavours that continue to a long and zesty finish.

Winemaker: James Ceccato

Food Match: The wine is best enjoyed with lightly fried fish, a new season vegetable stack or just as an aperitif.

Cellaring: Cellaring: This wine has been made to drink now but will cellar for 2 years.
