AC Pure dark blackberries and liquorice make for an enticing nose. This flows onto a mineral drenched palate with wonderful salinity and mouthwatering acidity backed up by fine-grained tannins. Cool elegant and effortless.

AR Captivating sage and sweet dark berry fruit exudes from this wine. With its richly concentrated cassis and light herbal undertones, it is a very enjoyable sip. Fines, sinewy tannis and elegant acidity render the finish extremely charming.

RG Griotte cherries and fresh blackberries give youthful, tantalising aromas which unfold onto s deliciously elegant palate. The tannins are firm and this has great potential, promising to evolve gracefully with time.
