The 2015 Berton Vineyard Winemakers Reserve Black Shiraz is a relatively inexpensive wine that shows a deep purple/black colour with fading pink hues.

The nose offers over generous redcurrant and black fruits with redcurrant and plums coming to the fore. The palate is soft with red black/red fruits dominating.

The oak is not overpowering allowing the wine to shine. This wine is medium bodied with acid/oak and tannins adding to the texture but not getting in the way of the fruit. A beauty for the paltry price of \$14 (rrp).

If you missed out on the 2015 vintage, then pick up a bottle of the recently released 2016 Winemakers Reserve Shiraz – it promises to be just as good!
