“Planted high above the Barossa Valley at High Eden, nearly 500m altitude, the ‘Bonsai’ vineyard is the original vineyard for Berton, planted in 1993, and lends its eponymous name to Berton’s flagship Shiraz. Intense and densely structured, the wine shows wild strawberry and blueberry flavours with hints of cherry cordial, white pepper and cocoa. A mint nuance adds lift to the rich, full-flavoured palate and leads onto a savoury finish. Plenty of depth and texture, a scrumptious wine asking for slow-roasted leg of lamb with garlic and rosemary.”
